The position is responsible to develop and implement the strategic and operational plans for the physical assets of the hatchery. The position provides the Hatchery Manager with impacts of new and revised programs on the facilities. The position contributes to the development of policy with respect to facilities and equipment. Furthermore, it identifies and administers new facilities projects to be delivered.
