



Freshwater Fisheries Society of BC Scholarship Award

Award & Eligibility Requirements

Up to three awards annually, with a value of \$2000 each. Available to students enrolled in a fish culture or fisheries management program within a recognized post-secondary educational institution in British Columbia.

To be eligible applicants must have completed at least their first year of post secondary studies and plan to continue as a student, with the intent of establishing a career in British Columbia in one of the following fields: fish culture; recreational fisheries management; fisheries enhancement, conservation and/or research.

Application Requirements

Please submit a short essay (750 to 1000 words) outlining your career aspirations and how your past experience, interests, and chosen educational program will benefit BC's freshwater recreational fisheries upon your graduation.

Your application must also include:

- A copy of your recent transcript
- Your resumé
- The names and contact information of three references, including at least one academic and/or faculty member reference
- An indication that if you are the award recipient, you give permission to the Freshwater Fisheries Society of BC to publish your photo and application essay in their Newsletter

Seasonal employment opportunities may be available with the Freshwater Fisheries Society of BC. Please note that preference may be given to award recipients.
